#### Additional Doses

Additional doses of the mRNA COVID-19 vaccines are available for those who are immunocompromised 28 days after they complete the initial series. An additional dose of the Pfizer or Moderna vaccine is recommended for immunocompromised individuals to achieve maximum protection from the vaccine series. People are encouraged to talk to their health care provider about whether an additional dose is appropriate for them. #### **Boosters**

Residents who completed a two-dose series of the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine at least 5 months ago are encouraged to get a booster dose.

Residents who received the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine at least two months ago are encouraged to get a booster dose.

Residents may choose to receive any authorized or approved vaccine as their booster dose.
