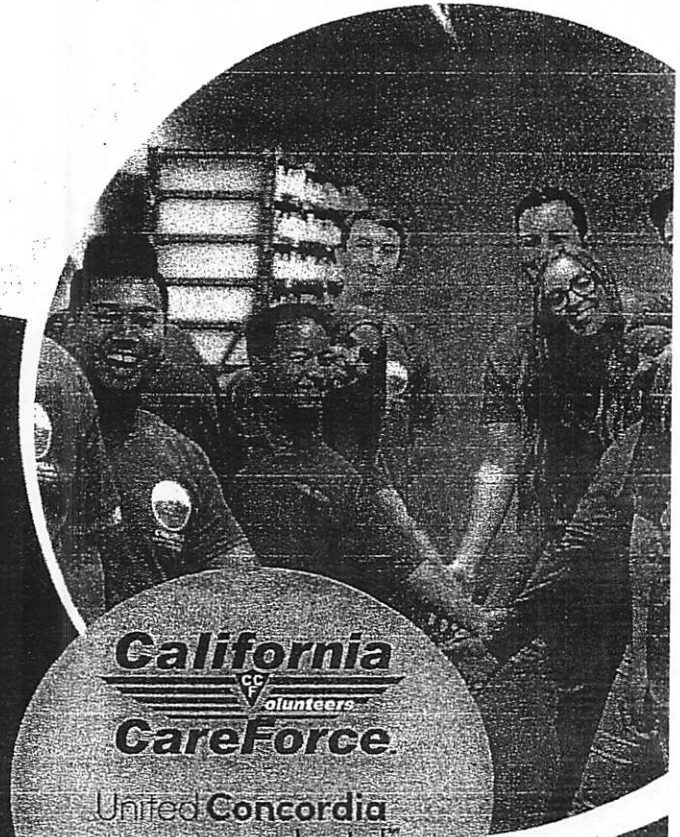

The library's summer reading program is a free, easy, and fun way for parents and teachers to encourage youth to develop and strengthen their reading fluency, comprehension and agency.

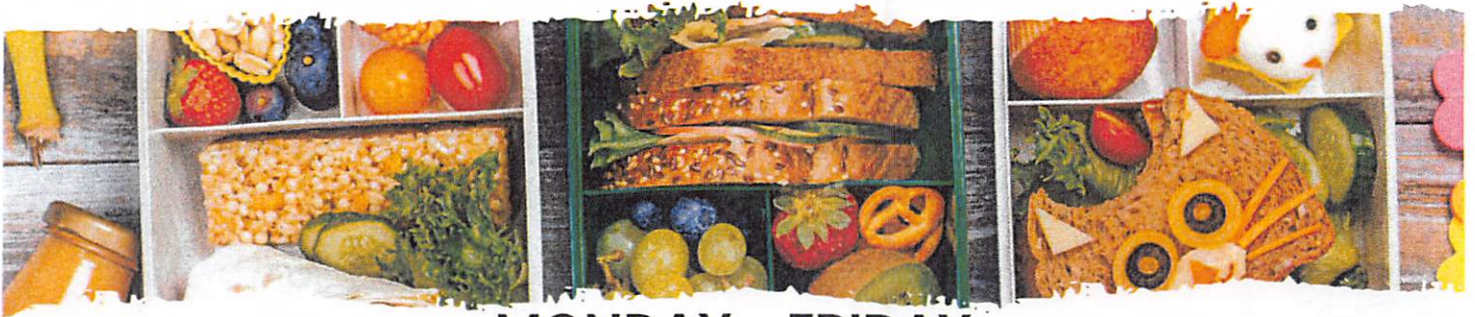

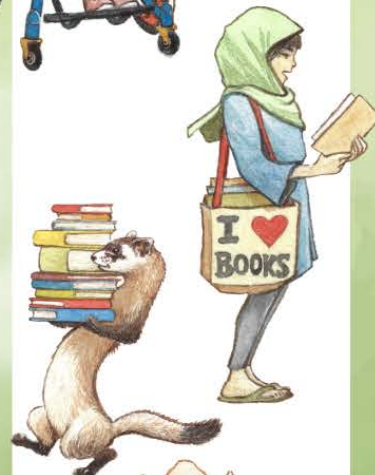
