Have Medi-Cal?

Three Easy Steps To Get Free COVID-19 Antigen Tests

1. Bring your Medi-Cal card(s) to your local pharmacy.

- You must go to the pharmacy counter to get your free COVID-19 tests.
- Each person with a Medi-Cal or Medicare card can receive up to 8 tests each month.
- Tests availability may be limited by store supply.

2. The pharmacist will write you a prescription, either physically or electronically, to be able to give free tests with no co-pay. *They can use the prescription sheet below.*

3. Take your tests home. If you need more tests next month, repeat these steps.

Test It


Have symptoms or a recent exposure? Take an at-home COVID-19 test!

Treat It

Test positive? Talk to a medical provider right away about medicines to fight COVID-19. Find out more at covid19.ca.gov/treatment or call 1-833-422-4255 to schedule a FREE telehealth appointment.

Beat It

Help get over COVID-19 faster! When you take COVID-19 medicine you can test negative sooner and reduce your risk of severe illness and Long COVID.

- La disponibilidad de las pruebas podría ser limitada según los suministros de la tienda.

2. El farmacéutico le hará una receta, ya sea física o electrónica, para poder darle pruebas gratis sin copago. Puede usar la hoja de órdenes de abajo.

3. Lleve las pruebas a casa. Si necesita más pruebas el mes que viene, repita estos pasos.

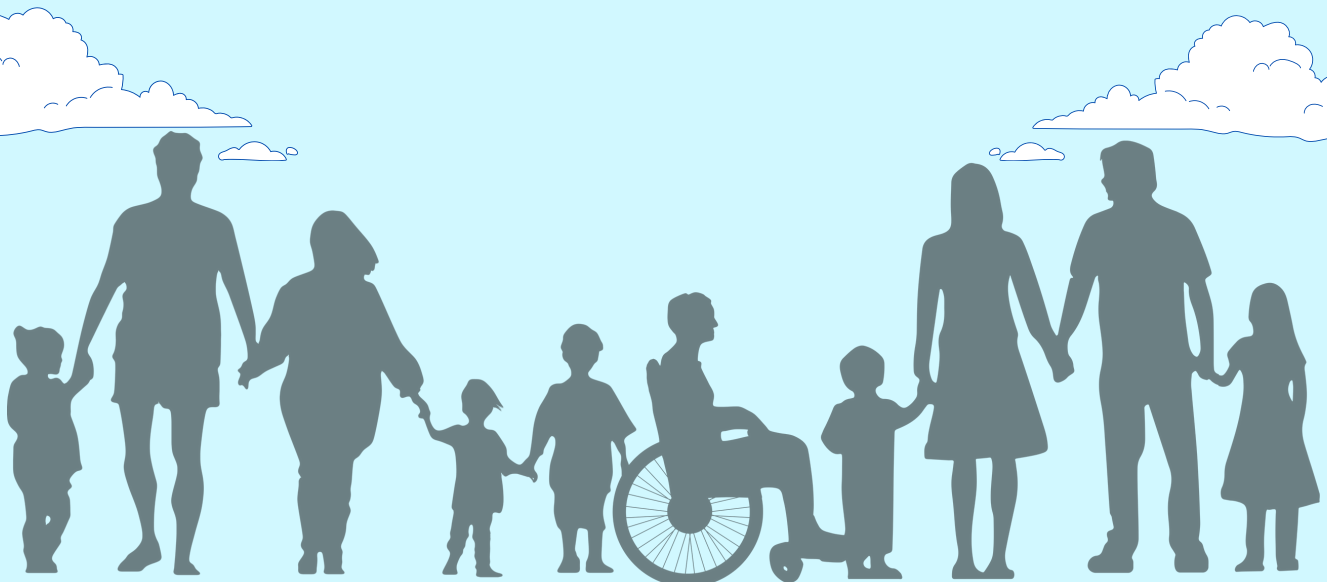

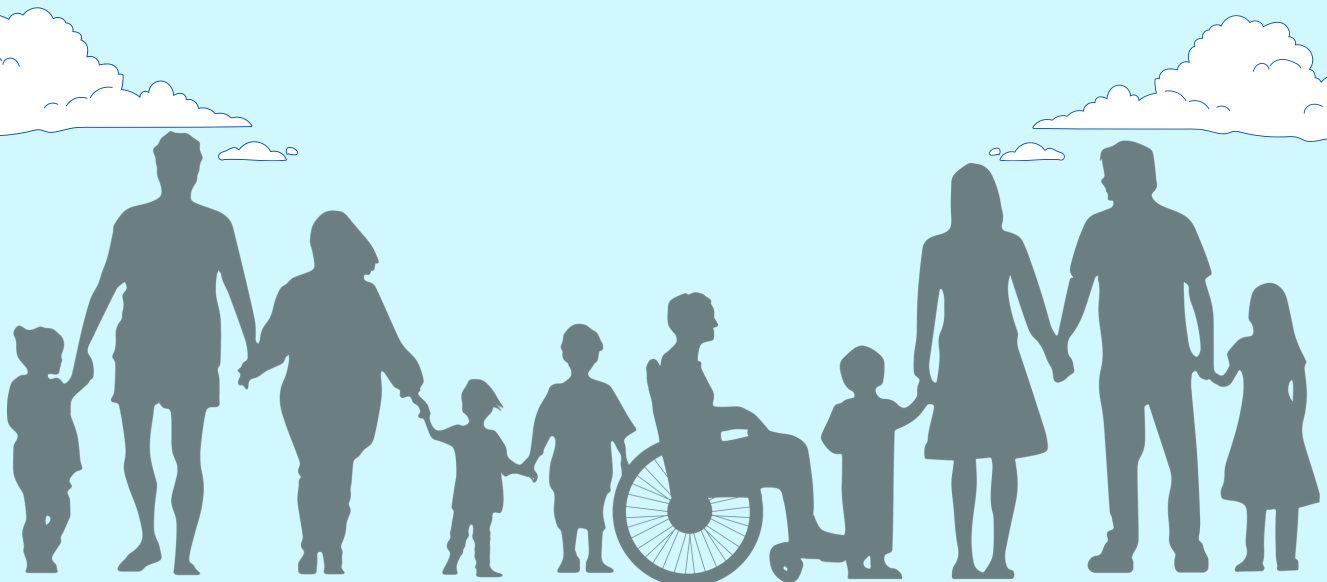
