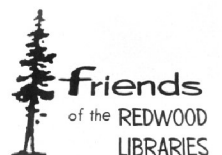

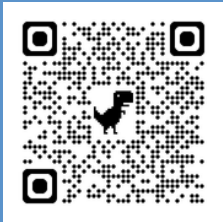

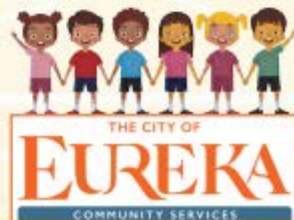

Toddler Fitness Fusion!

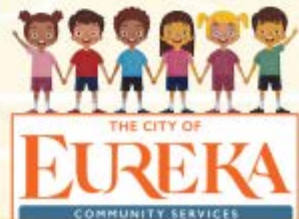

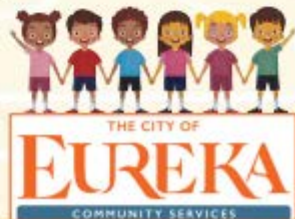

Triple P, or the Positive Parenting Program, is a free, evidence-based program designed to help parents and caregivers enhance their parenting skills and support their children's development.

Goal

Triple P aims to help parents raise confident, happy children and prevent or address behavioral and emotional issues.

Things to Know

- This program is evidence-based and approved for court-ordered requirements.
- Each session provides certificates for participants along with additional incentives.
