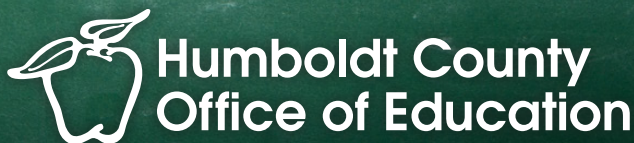

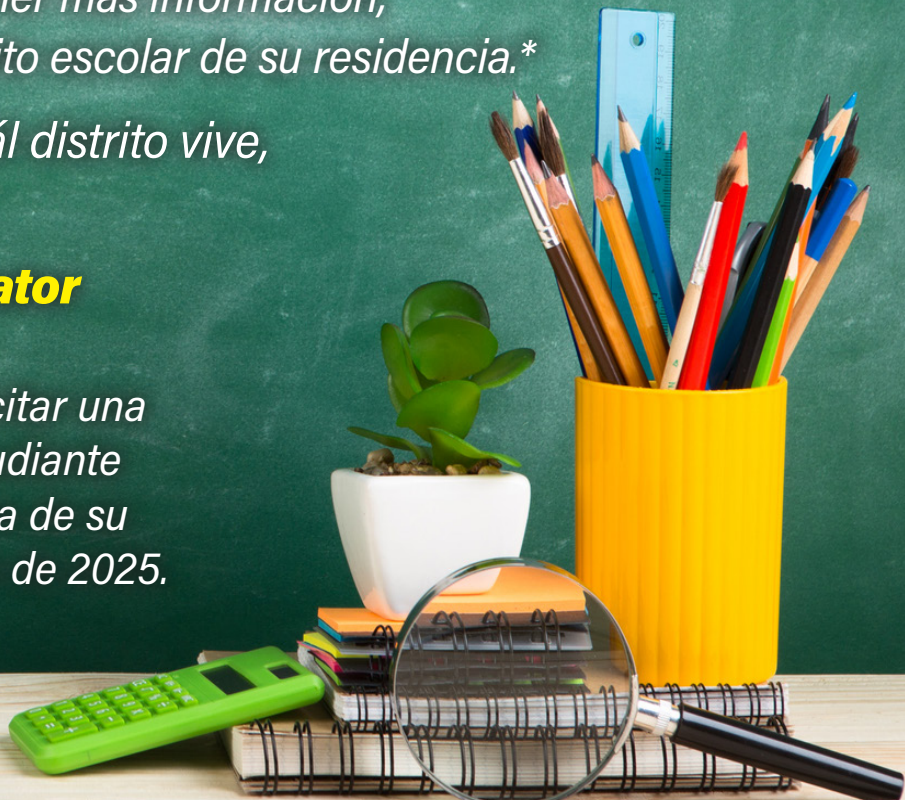

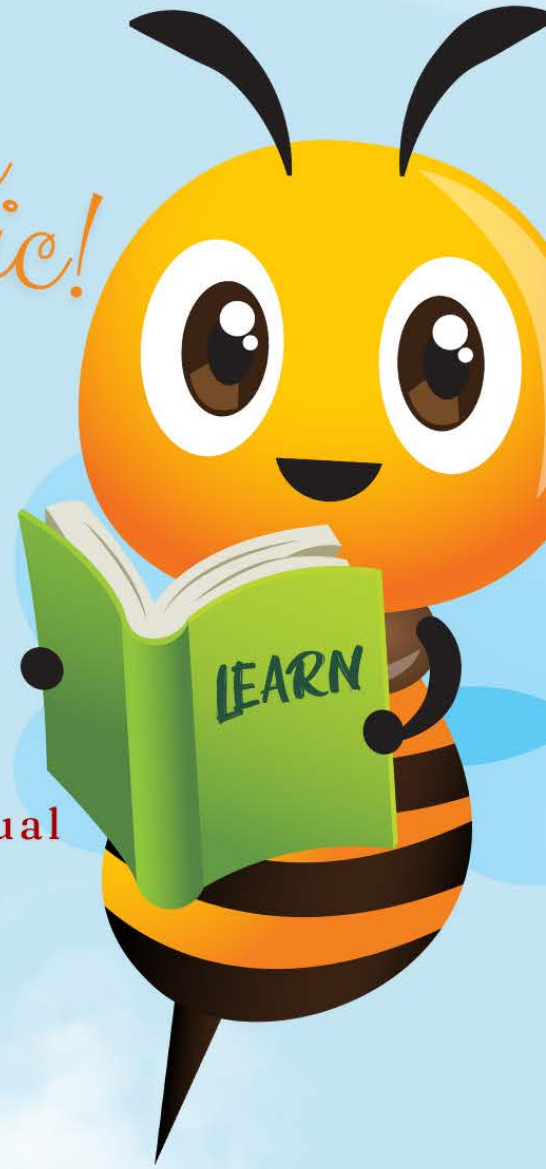

# Toddler Fitness Fusion!

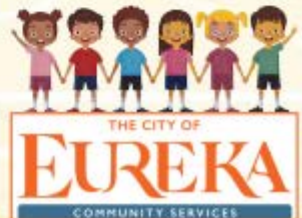

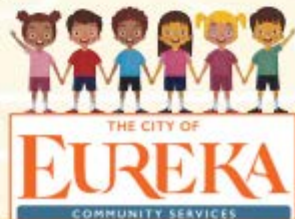
