Lead Teacher, Fortuna

The Lead Teacher is responsible for the development and implementation of all classrooms activities. The Team Teacher will work closely with the Center Director/Teacher to coordinate services for children, families, and the program. They must maintain the program consistency regarding rules, individualization for the children, and program expectations. Must have 12 core in ECE/CD (with 3 units in Infant/Toddler Development or Curriculum) and meet Associate Teacher Level on the Child Development Permit Matrix. Year Round Program.

Classroom Assistant Alice Birney

Under the supervision of the Center Director or Team Teacher, the Assistant Teacher is responsible for: assisting with the supervision of all children; developing and implementing classroom activities; working cooperatively with and supporting other classroom staff and volunteers; and assisting with the general maintenance of program facilities to ensure the health and safety of the children of the program. This is a non-exempt position.

The Cook implements the cycle menu in accordance with NCS policies, procedures and established practices.

Purchases and prepares food, completes Child Care Food Program paperwork. Paperwork includes menu production records, monthly adjustment sheets, food transport records, inventories, cycle menus, attendance sheets and food purchase receipts, and supports center staff with nutrition activities in the classroom. non-exempt position.

The Teacher is responsible for the development and implementation of classroom activities. The Teacher must be enthusiastic and energetic about working with young children, parents and other staff members. Must have 12 core units in ECE/CD (with 3 units in Infant/Toddler Development or Curriculum), meet Associate Teacher level on Child Development Permit Matrix or higher.

ERSEA Enrollment/Recruitment Technician Bilingual Preferred

Responsible for ensuring compliance with federal and state regulations related to Head Start, Early Head Start, and other early childhood education programs. They work with families to determine eligibility, conduct recruitment activities, process enrollment, track and enter attendance. In partnership with ERSEA team maintains uploaded attachments (scans) by processing data and moving attachments to the appropriate module. Produce reports from ChildPlus that meet the needs of program areas as requested or required by program needs. Address any inconsistencies with reports in partnership with Managers or Directors. High school graduation or equivalent and three years of relevant experience.. Two years' experience and demonstrated competency in computer office component software, such as MS Word, MS Excel or similar applications.

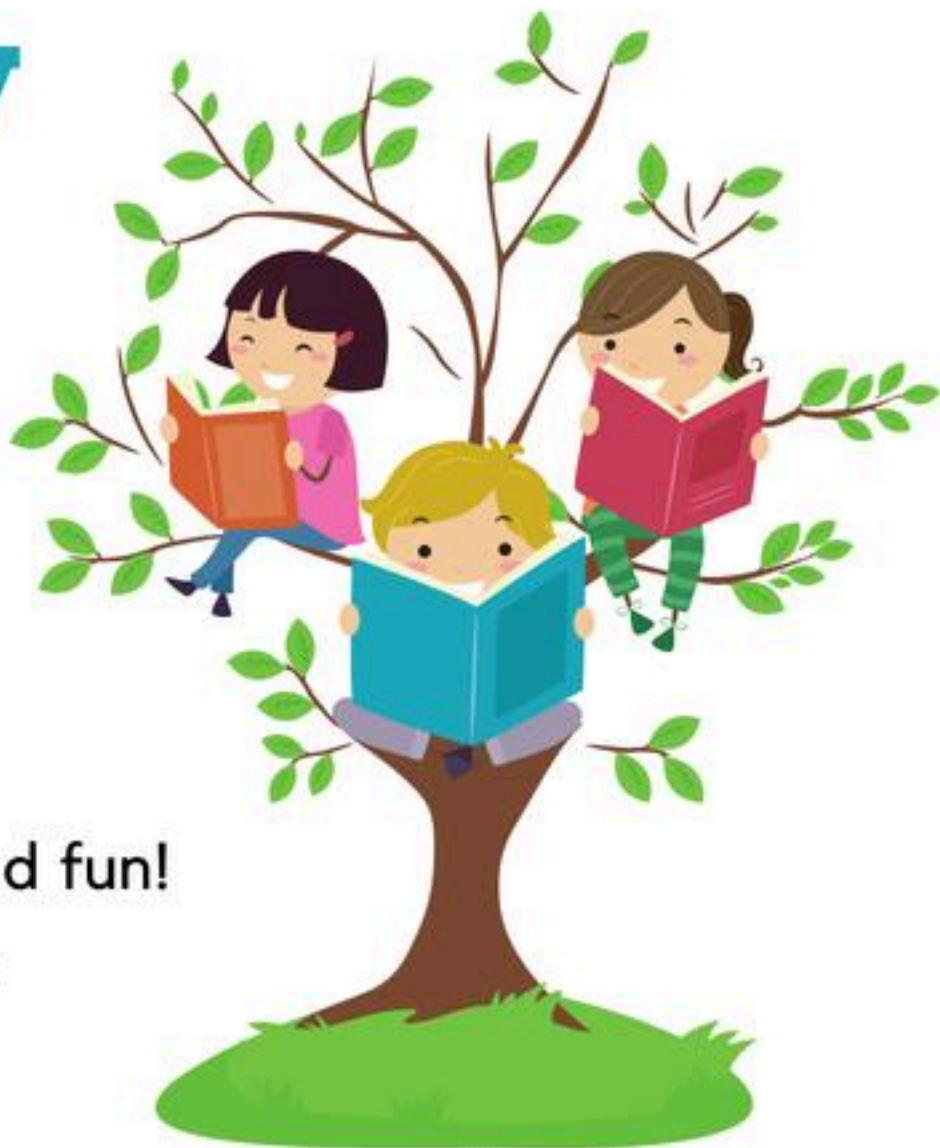

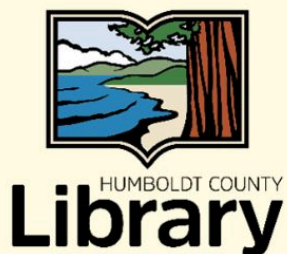
